



REGULATION

Art. 1 - Date and place

a - The "999 Miglia – randonnée of Rome and of the South", it is a non-competitive cycling event that takes place in Italy every four years starting on 2017. The departure date of the first edition is scheduled on 24/25 June 2017 and the whole event starts and finishes in Rome.

b - The randonnée (over 1600 km) is an ultra bike marathon that is part of the ARI circuit called "Italy of the Grand Tour", a Grand Patent ARI consists of four randonnées over 1200 km which take place every four years each. They are open to all Italian and foreign cyclists as per the BRM and ARI regulations currently in force. Those who obtain the approval in the four patents will be rewarded with the highest degree and honour called "GRAN RANDONNEUR OF ITALY".

Art. 2 - Rules, route, and departures

The 999 Miles takes place on a single route of about 1600 km and 10,000 mt / hm with 3 modes:

1. Patent BRM - In autonomy, within 150 hours
2. Patent BRI - In autonomy within 168 hours
3. Diploma GRAND TOURIST - With tour operators in 180 hours (8 days and 7 nights).

The third option opens a new formula to give the opportunity to cyclists to experience the similar way of randonneur but with the support of a tour operator.

Starting line and finish line are provided by special structures placed in Piazza San Francesco d'Assisi (Trastevere) in Rome.

There are 3 different departure times:

- Saturday 24th June at 7am departure of Grand Tourists
- Saturday 24th June from 7pm to 8pm departure of randonneurs patent BRI
- Sunday 25th June from 7am to 8am depart of randonneurs patent BRM



The Rando Point, their location, the services they provide and the list of facilities will be announced to members and posted on the site.

At the starting line, depending on the options chosen by each, will be delivered 3 different travel cards:

- one for randonneur who want to obtain the patent BRM (within 150 hours). If you exceed the maximum time you can always achieve the BRI patent.
- one for randonneur who want to achieve the BRI patent (within 168 hours). If you exceed the maximum time you can always obtain the Diploma of GrandTourist.
- one for the GrandTourists who wish to obtain the Diploma of GrandTourist (within 180 hours).

The route will be marked with small adhesive arrows but everyone will have to rely on the "Road Book" and "Map". The floor plans and GPS tracks of the routes can be downloaded from www.audaxitalia.it

For departures of 7pm of Saturday will be mandatory front and rear working lights installed on the bicycle in accordance with the Highway Code.

Art. 3 - Requirements for participation

The participation at the 999 Miglia is reserved for all licensed cyclists regularly registered with the FCI or promotion companies officially recognized Italian or foreign sport companies which provide the required insurance coverages. Cyclists must be aged between 17 and 69 years old.

The participation of members in the categories amateurs/ciclosportivi over 69 years (up to 75 years of age) shall be allowed with the requirement to follow a pace of no longer than the minimum expected average.

Italian and foreign national non-members can also participate, but only in possession of medical certificate. Competitive sports certificate must be valid on the date of the event. All participants must provide the document by May 31st, 2017 by sending it to the address indicated in the e-confirmation mail.

Art. 4 - Participation fees and enrolment

The basic registration fee is 99,9 €. In the first edition of the 999 Miglia pre-registrations are provided.

The organization will award the identification numbers in accordance with the procedures described below:

1 - On the 1st October 2016 on the website www.audaxitalia.it will be opened at a cost of 10 €, pre-registrations for participation in the Patent BRM and BRI. These will close on November 30th, 2016.

When the deadline of 30th November has passed, the pre-registered will receive an e-mail that will indicate how to carry out the definitive registration.

2 - Registrations will follow the following rules and dates:

- From December 1st to December 31st, 2016 registration will be available only to pre-registered until the restricted entry (all pre-registered have the right to register any case because the limited number will be determined based on the number of pre-registered);

- From 1st January to 28th February will be possible new entries in place of pre-registered who have not completed the enrolment and / or until the achievement of a limited number expected by the organization:

- 1st to 31st March 2017 will be possible up to 50 new registrations with surcharge;



- Please note that over 69 are considered all those born before 31/12/1947, even if they have not yet reached 69 years of age at the date of the event as born from June to December of 1947.

Art. 5 - Package Rando and BAGDrop

Participation in the 999 Miglia is permitted only to those who have paid the fee and handed over to the organization the Medical Certificate.

The organization of 999 Miglia may at any time and at its sole discretion, without prior additional motivation, to decide whether to accept the registration of anyone.

The registration fee includes:

- The "PACK RANDO" with free gifts and souvenir of the event;
- The IDENTIFICATION NUMBER to be placed on the bike;
- The road book and the MAP 999 Miglia with the details of the routes, and the refreshment and stamps;
- TRAVEL CARD on which to affix the control stamps;
- Refreshments and ADMISSIONS along the way (free of charge or at a discounted fee as shall be determined at the time of completion of the logistics and published on the site no later than the month of January 2017:
- Refreshment at the end of the event;
- MEDAL and the DIPLOMA of finisseur.

For all those who request it will be possible a BAG DROP service whose cost will be communicated upon registration.

Art. 6 - Payment

The payment of the participants' enrollment is scheduled exclusively online at www.audaxitalia.it by PayPal, credit card or Bank Transfer.

Art. 7 - Validity of registration

The registration may be expected regularly valid only after completing the electronic process resulting credited in favour of the organizer, the sending of the medical certificate or the documentation belonging to recognized sports organizations.

In case of failure to submit the above documentation by April 30th, 2017, any paid will not be reimbursed.

Art. 8 - Replace or cancellation of participation

No substitutions are allowed.

Art. 9 - Getting Started Control and withdrawal identification numbers

The bikes equipment check should be carried out at the premises of the following departures:

- Friday, June 23rd from 14:00h to 19:00h for the Patent BRI
- Saturday, June 24th from 9:00h to 15:00h for the Patent BRI
- Saturday, June 24th from 9:00h to 19:00h for Patent BRM

Each participant will have to show proof of identity, will sign the resolution of liability, the participation document and, as a result, will be personally delivered the "PACK RANDO" with the identification number and useful things for the journey. Proxies are not allowed.



Art. 10 -Typology of bicycles

All kinds of bicycle with chain drive are allowed, only if moved by muscle power alone.

Art. 11 Highway Code -Respect

Every cyclist participant has the obligation of the protective helmet and respect the Highway Code, being aware that the roads are not manned and must be considered as a free personal tour.

Art. 12 -Responsibility

The ARI (AudaxRandonneur Italy) and the organizing ASD may in no circumstances be held responsible for accidents that may happen during the randonnée patent. The ARI and the the organizing ASD are not liable for theft or damage to bicycles and accessories, or for damage caused to third parties or from the latter caused the cyclist.

Art. 13 – Required equipment

For the night circulation, or in cases in which the visibility is not sufficient, the bicycle belonging to the cyclist must be provided with a front and rear lighting system fixed solidly and in a constant state of operation. The cyclist is also obliged to wear accessories garments with reflective powers during the night or whenever visibility is insufficient.

Art. 14 - Autonomy and self-reliance of the participants

Each rider must personally provide to all necessary equipment for the completion of the randonnée patent and, except for points where the check is located, it is prohibited along the way any form of care provided by individuals who follow the cyclists and aimed at allowing the smooth continuation of the trial.

Art. 15 – Endorsement and storage Travel Card

Each cyclist receives a Travel Card in addition to the road book with instructions on the route and the checkpoints. By Check point the cyclist must be checked that the Travel Card for the regular endorsement. The Travel Card must be preserved with care and returned on arrival.

Art. 16 -Other mode validation of Travel Card

The endorsement of the Travel Card is carried out at the checkpoint indicated by the same ASD organizing staff. If the checkpoint is not manned by staff of the organization, the cyclist can endorse the Travel Card, which validates the location by: selfie, shops, petrol stations or railway, police, city police, post office or another tool which is obtainable from the place and the time of passage.

Art. 17 - Gates

The passage in each checkpoint must be done between the hours of opening and closing time stated on the Travel Card. The cyclist must respect those time zones. The non-compliance with the



time zones result in the non-approval of the randonnée patent even if it is made on arrival in the time limit.

Art. 18 –Validity of the Travel Card

On arrival, each cyclist must present to the organizing ASD staff the Travel Card with all authentications to be approved.

Art. 19 Approval and awards

The randonnée patent is not a competition and does not involve any charts and no recognition awards unless the medal and the finisseur diploma.

The ASD organizer, at the end of the randonnée patent, will draw up a list of cyclists approved in alphabetical order with the time spent using the official ARI model downloaded from www.audaxitalia.it site without affixing any modification.

Art. 20 - Infractions, penalties and suspensions

In any of the following cases will not be issued the Patent and will be carried out ARI reporting to:

- Participation with the identification number of other people;
- The unauthorized sale of its membership;
- Making detours is not allowed in order to shorten it;
- Carrying out part of the path with the aid of means mechanized different from its own bicycle;
- Abusive and insulting behaviour towards staff organization;
- Jet of waste outside space used at the Refreshment and controls.

It appeals to the public spirit of each one because the territories along the route remain clean.

Art. 21 - Complaints

The cyclist who should feel the unjust decision of the ASD organizer to consider not regularly completed his rehearsal, must claim in writing within 12 hours of the end of the patent addressing ARI (AudaxRandonneur Italy).

Art. 22 - Cancellation of the event

If, for serious and motivated force majeure, the event is not run the amount paid at the registration it will be refunded to the 50%.

Art. 23 - Changes

The organization reserves the right at any time to make changes to the Regulation. The website www.audaxitalia.it is the only official company of the event information. Therefore, all official communications will be made known only through it.



Art. 24 - Approval, consent, authorization, etc.

With the request to participate in the 999 Miglia in the manner provided in this Regulation, each participant will have to sign the agreement offered by the organizer.

Art. 25 - Processing and recording of personal data

The processing and registration of personal data will be regularly carried out.

Art. 26 - Amendments to Regulation

The organizer reserves the right to modify these regulations and to take the utmost urgency decisions in particular and exceptional cases not covered by the same.
